<u>Dalwhinnie Lizzie's Dram</u> – Mulled orange notes mingle with American white oak to create a rich fruity dram.	48.0% £10.00
<u>Glengoyne 10-year-old</u> – Fresh green apples, toffee, and a hint of nuttiness.	40.0% £3.50
<u>Glengoyne 12-year-old</u> - Lemon zest, toffee apples and a scent of coconut.	40.0% £4.00
<u>Glengoyne 17-year-old</u> – Smooth and medium bodied. Cask strength with vanilla, dried fruit, oak, and orchard fruits.	57.3% £14.00
<u>Glengoyne 19-year-old</u> - Cask strength. Spiced orange, sweet red apple, and plum jam on the nose. Layers of soft oak, spice, and cinnamon on the tongue.	56.6% £15.00
<u>Glengoyne 21-year-old</u> – Sultanas, hazelnuts, dried fruit, rich spice, Christmas cake, honey, and a long cinnamon finish.	43.0% £12.00
<u>Glengoyne 30-year-old</u> – Intense sherry trifle then the rich complexity of cinnamon, cloves, and tangy marmalade.	46.8% £35.00
<u>Glengoyne Legacy Chapter Two</u> – Sweet fruity notes, gentle spices, sweet oak and dates.	48.0% £5.00
<u>GlenDronach 15-year-old Revival</u> – Oloroso and PX casks combined to create a rich sherry flavour packed with fruit.	46.0% £4.50
<u>Loch Lomond 12-year-old</u> – Deep fruity character. Peach and pear layered with vanilla sweetness and hints of peat and smoke.	46.0% £4.00
<u>Talisker Skye</u> – Well rounded and sweet. Packed with fresh citrus, sweet smoke, peppery spice, and maritime notes.	45.8% £4.50
<u>Wolfburn Highland Festival Edition 2019</u> – Lightly peaty. Matured in bourbon Casks. Sweet vanilla, fresh pastries, banana, apple and smoke.	46.0% £5.00

Speyside

<u>Benromach 10-year-old</u> – First fill bourbon and sherry casks. Delicate forest Fruits, creamy malt, a touch of smoke, and rich sherry notes.	43.0% £4.50
<u>GlenAlachie 12-year-old</u> – Matured in a mix of virgin oak, Oloroso, and PX Casks to provide sweet flavours of honey, marzipan, and butterscotch.	46.0% £5.00
<u>GlenAlachie 15-year-old</u> – Another heavily sherried offering. Walnuts, dates, raisins, winter spices and stem ginger.	46.0% £6.50
<u>GlenAlachie 30-year-old</u> – Oloroso and PX cask maturation provides a taste Of dark chocolate, fruitcake, raisins, honey and figs with treacle, orange zest and nutmeg.	48.9% £37.50
<u>Knockando 18-year-old</u> – Sweet and Fruity. Orange, strawberry, almond, Dark chocolate, malt and leather characteristics shine through.	43.0% £6.50
<u>Macallan 12-year-old Double Cask</u> – American and European oak sherry casks create a delicious blend of honeyed wood spices and citrus balanced with raisins and caramel.	40.0% £6.00
<u>Macallan Rare Cask Black</u> – Rich and full bodied. A combination of peat smoke dried fruits, nutmeg, ginger, oak, dates, figs, and raisins.	48.0% £35.00
<u>Mortlach 12-year-old</u> – Sweet and spicy with notes of demerara sugar, dark Chocolate, cherry jam and light tobacco.	
<u>Tamdhu 12-year-old</u> – Notes of banana, raspberry jam, malty biscuits, and Toasted oak leading to ground cinnamon, dried fruits, and Scottish tablet.	43.0% £4.50
<u>Tamdhu 15-year-old</u> – Notes of juicy apricot, raspberry, lemon tart, and almonds leading to malty biscuit, cream sherry and vanilla.	43.0% £6.50
<u>Tamdhu Batch Strength 4</u> – Vanilla and berry fruits followed by sherry, oak spice, and dried fruits with a sharp citrus twist.	57.8% £6.00
<u>Tamdhu Batch Strength 5</u> – Creamy and rich with vanilla, Brazil nuts, spice, and dried fruits leading to a sweet fruity finish.	59.8% £6.50

Campbelltown

Springbank 10-year-old – Bourbon and sherry casks matured with smoke, vanilla, nutmeg, cinnamon, and the salty tang characteristic of the distillery. **46.0% £5.50**

Lowland

Lindores MCDXCIV – Smooth with a creamy texture. Mellow vanilla, dried fruit, citrus, and a hint of spice with a delicate lingering finish. **46.0% £5.00**

Lindores Aqua Vitae – Infused with botanicals from the grounds of Lindore Abbey. Great with ginger beer. **40.0% £3.50**

Islay

Ardberg Drum – Dried fruit soaked in rum, stem ginger, mint imperials, fiery peat and a hint of salinity. **46.0% £8.00**

Bunnahabhain 12-year-old – Light with fruity notes. Nutty flavours with a slight of sweetness and hints of vanilla and caramel. **46.3% £4.00**

Kilchoman 9-year-old distillery exclusive – peaty with dried oak, vanilla and Christmas spices. **57.8% £8.00**

Lagavulin 16-Year-old – Intense, peat smoke, rich, sweet, and a little salt. **43.0% £5.00**

Laphroaig Select – Peaty with lemon, green apple, and mint with developing spice notes. **40.0% £3.50**

Laphroaig 10 Year Sherry Cask – A combination of sherry and smoke in the typical medicinal Laphroaig style with sweet spicy aromas. **48.0% £7.00**

Octomore 10-year-old 2008 – 167PPM of smokiness. Oak, spices, mulled wine, tobacco and all the peat. **56.8% £14.00**

Smokehead – Intensely rich yet subtly sweet. Immense smoke and notes of sea salt. **43.0% £4.50**

Smokehead Rum Rebel – Fiery peat smoke and burnt marshmallows softened with caramelised fruit. **46.0% £5.00**

Scottish Blends

Big Peat – A blend of Islay malts. Caol Ila for sweetness, Bowmore for Balance, Ardbeg for medicinal earthiness and Port Ellen for a degree of elegance. **46.0% £4.50**

Scallywag – A blend of Speyside malts that have been predominantly Sherry casked. Includes Mortlach, Macallan and Glentrothes. **46.0% £4.50**

English Whisky

The Lakes Whisky Maker’s Reserve 3 – Matured in Oloroso, PX, cream sherry and red wine casks. Warming oak spice leads into notes of golden syrup chai spices and dates. **52.0% £6.00**

The Lakes Whisky Maker’s Reserve 4 – Another sherry led casking. Intense Sherry, prune juice, raisins, sultanas, figs, maple syrup and dark chocolate. **52.0% £6.00**

The Lakes The One Signature Blend – A slow build of smoky spices and toasted oak balanced by waves of caramel and citrus. **46.6% £4.00**

The Lakes The One Sherry Cask – Chocolate, dates, nutty barley, and crushed black pepper with a hint of cask char. **46.6% £4.50**

The Lakes The One Port Cask – Warming and spicy with black pepper alongside nutmeg, cinnamon, orange oil, roasted nuts and berries. **46.6% £4.50**

The Lakes The One Orange Wine Cask – Gentle fragrant peat smoke with floral hints, zesty orange, tropical fruit, and a pinch of tobacco. **46.6% £4.50**

The Lakes The One Moscatel Wine Finish – Honeyed malt, dark chocolate, strawberry jam, buttered crumpets, clove, and nutmeg. **46.6% £4.50**

The Lakes Steel Bonnets - Creamy, slightly nutty and full bodied. Notes of vanilla, ginger, nutmeg, and hints of dried fruits. **46.6% £5.00**

The Lakes Colheita – Colheita port and bourbon casked. Vibrant and fruity on the nose. Complex palate with notes of prunes, stewed plums, and cinnamon with a long-lasting finish. **52.0% £6.00**

The Lakes Le Gouter – “A childhood cakeshop excursion in Paris” was the inspiration. Notes of Crème Anglaise and jasmine plus a touch of pear, citrus zest and freshly baked madeleines. **49.5% £15.00**

The Lakes Miramar – Versatile and expansive. Bursting with stone fruit Character contrasting with vanilla and gentle spices. **54.0% £12.50**

Japanese Whisky

The Yamazaki Distiller’s Reserve – Dried berries, light oak, white peach and spice. **43.0% £6.50**

That Boutique-y Whisky Company 21-year-old Blend – A mix of red and black berries, cherry cola, dried orange peel, creamy fudge, nutty oak, exotic honey, bittersweet herbs, winter spice, and cherry blossom. **47.7% £18.00**

Nikka 12-year-old – Green apple freshness, rich fruitcake spiciness, Butterscotch, and green peppercorn. **43.0% £5.00**

Swedish Whisky

Mackmyra New Union Single Casking – Bottled exclusively for the New Union. Sherry, nuttiness, Christmas cake, warm spices, and dried fruit. **46.5% £5.00**

Mackmyra Mack – Bright, fresh character with notes of vanilla, pear and citrus. **40.0% £3.75**

Mackmyra Vinterglöd – Casked in Swedish mulled wine and Pedro Ximenez sherry casks. Orange, candied fruit, and almond with ginger like spice. **46.1% £4.50**

Mackmyra Svensk EK – Swedish oak casks create a spicy character with notes of sandalwood, dried ginger, black pepper, roasted oak barrel and herbs. **46.1% £4.50**

Mackmyra Svensk Rok Amerikansk EK – Slightly smoky and spicy aroma with a smokier flavour and peaty juniper notes. **46.1% £4.50**

Mackmyra Bjorksav – Using birch sap wine casks gives this floral whisky a fresh spiciness and sweet notes of vanilla fudge.
