Benromach 10-year-old – First fill bourbon and sherry casks. Delicate forest fruits, creamy malt, a touch of smoke, and rich sherry notes. **43.0% £4.50**

Benriach 10-year-old – Hearty barley backed up by orchard fruits and toasted almonds alongside a hint of herbaceous oak. **43.0% £4.50**

GlenAllachie 12-year-old – Matured in a mix of virgin oak, Oloroso, and PX Casks to provide sweet flavours of honey, marzipan, and butterscotch. **46.0% £5.00**

GlenAllachie 15-year-old – Another heavily sherried offering. Walnuts, dates, raisins, winter spices and stem ginger. **46.0% £6.50**

GlenAllachie 30-year-old – Oloroso and PX cask maturation provides a taste of dark chocolate, fruitcake, raisins, honey and figs with treacle, orange zest and nutmeg. **48.9% £40.00**
